We have followed the subjects of an intensive Juniorate that are specified in the formation book and those that prepare for the apostolic mission: Charisma, Claudina's pedagogy, Vows, St. Claudina's spiritual and human itinerary, the geography of the Congregation, the



secretariat, the use of social networks, interreligious dialogue, maturity in the following of Jesus, emotional

intelligence (as a transversal axis), the physical dimension of the person and follow-up, foundations and fundraising, school ministry, organization of schools and strategic plan, leadership, government and synodality, approach to the land of Jesus, preferences of the last general chapter, reconfiguration, among others.
